The 2016 GreenFest will take place on **Saturday, April 30, from 9 AM—1 PM at the Captain Samuel Brown School, 150 Lynn St., Peabody.** The theme for GreenFest this year is STEAM education for a sustainable future. Don't miss the opportunity to recycle electronics for a minimal fee; this will be the final year for e-recycling at GreenFest. There will also be large scale paper shredding (the first 2 boxes are free) and the chance to recycle numerous items: shoes & old shoe laces, textiles, cell phones, can tabs, books and eye glasses (all for free).

Salem Sound Coastwatch, will be shedding light on the very important topic of flood mitigation with a focus on hydrology, geomorphology, and coastal and regional geology. Small Biz Computing, the creator of the "green machine" computer, will host a clinic where attendees can watch students build a gaming computer throughout the day at GreenFest. Visitors can also visit a pop-up coffee bar while listening to live music, and watch a 3D printer print objects which will be provided by the Library's Creativity Lab. In addition, there will be student sustainable science fair projects, and fun art activities for everyone.

Brown School teachers have been committed to educating students about environmental conservation and have been members of the Green Team 2008–2015, won the Excellence in Environmental Education Award in 2008—2015, and won 1st place in the Recycle Bowl in 2015.

To be eligible to receive a rebate, residential customers must complete the application which can be downloaded from the PMLP website www.pmlp.com or obtained at our Office, 201 Warren St. Ext., Peabody. Customers can also call PMLP at (978) 531-5975 to receive an application.

Completed applications must include a copy of the dated sales receipt and a copy of your recent PMLP Bill. Once approved, the customer's account will be credited within six to eight weeks. All appliances must be installed at the account location and PMLP reserves the right to verify installation. PMLP residential customer ENERGY STAR® rebates are limited to one rebate of each of the qualified appliances (to the left) every three years.

This rebate is eligible for purchases made January 1, 2016 through December 31, 2016, or while rebate funds are available for this year's program. For more information, call PMLP at (978) 531-5975 or visit www.pmlp.com.

5. Copy of your most recent PMLP bill; and
6. A copy of the AHRI Certificate.
